Please report environmental issues to us and we'll aim to respond within two working days.

Environmental issues can include:

- Condition of property that is causing a hazard to health
- Littering/fly-tipping
- Dog fouling
- Graffiti

Anti-social behaviour

Please report ASB to us and we'll contact you within two working days.

Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) is defined as behaviour by a person, not of the same household, which causes, or is likely to cause, harassment, alarm, or distress to someone.

ASB includes:

- Threats of violence or actual violence
- Harassment and intimidation
- Threats of criminal damage or actual criminal damage
- Constant and unreasonable noise nuisance
- Alcohol or drug related nuisance
